## Boys & Girls Club of San Dieguito

Boys & Girls Clubs of San Dieguito is dedicated to providing positive activities to develop the education, health, self-esteem, and character of youth. We serve those youth who need us most and turn no child away due to financial limitations. Our doors opened in 1966 and, for 54 years, we have identified and acted on the needs of our community and worked with youth from disadvantaged economic, social, and family circumstances. We level the playing field through activities in our core program areas: the Arts; Character & Leadership Development; Education & Career Development; Health & Life Skills; Sports, Fitness & Recreation; and Technology.

In 2020, our seven Clubhouses located in Carmel Valley, Del Mar, Encinitas, and Solana Beach served youth ages 18 months through 18. We serve nearly 6,800 children and teens in our After School Programs and Camps and impact over 16,700 youth throughout San Diego through our camps, specialty programs, and community services. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our Clubhouses were closed for three months, shifting to virtual programming for our youth members in April. In June, we reopened four of our seven Clubhouses (at limited capacity) for Summer Day Camps. We've also been able to re-open our Aquatics Center, Bulldogs Basketball programs, and Carmel Valley Montessori School, as well as continue online music lessons through our Youth Arts Academy. While local support has helped us reopen, we estimate we will only be able to serve one-third of the youth we normally do this summer, at three times the cost. As such, we are launching a \$1.5M campaign to help keep our doors open through 2020.
