District 5340 Governor Luis Carranza Visit



We were honored to have Luis Carranza, Rotary District 5340 Governor, visit our club today. Governor Carranza was born in Tijuana, at the age of seven he came across the border to a new world and new culture. Family, love, faith, and resiliency were key components in his growth. From his father he learned the importance of showing up every day with integrity. Raised in the east county he volunteered as a candy stripper on the Oncology Unit of Grossmont Hospital, played the violin in the San Diego Youth Symphony, and graduated from Grossmont HS.

He relayed the story on how his theme, "Don't Miss the Bus" came to fruition". While visiting Ensenada waiting for a bus to go downtown, he was talking to a confused couple who didn't speak the language and weren't sure where they were going. When the bus came, he told them to get on, the doors immediately closed. In making a choice to put someone else first, he missed the bus and found his mission. His message is that we as Rotarians need to "Unite for Good". Rotary is a place to help others, not only build programs but build people. Remember why we became Rotarians and why we are still Rotarians.

We were reminded that the Rotary Foundation is the heartbeat of Rotary. The Youth Programs are the seeds of Rotary, in mentoring the Interact and Rotaract Clubs we are the water for their growth.

April 24 - 26, 2026 he will be holding a multi-district Rotary Conference at the new Gaylord Pacific Resort in Chula Vista.
