# Sean Elo-Rivera Councilmember District 9 Chollas Water Shed

"Chollas Creek is a 32 square mile natural waterway and drainage system that traverses neighborhoods within City Heights, Oak Park, Encanto, Chollas View, Mt. View, Mt. Hope, Barrio Logan, and Southcrest, from its headwaters in La Mesa and Lemon Grove to San Diego Bay. Located in the Pueblo Watershed, Chollas Creek was a significant settlement for the Kumeyaay, and has amongst the richest cultural, biological, and geological assets in the region." – Groundwork San Diego

Councilmember Elo-Rivera will discuss his priorities for Chollas Creek and how he's working with Groundwork San Diego and other advocates and stakeholders to restore Chollas Creek to its natural state, which will bring long-sought environmental, recreational, and economic benefits to the communities within the watershed.

We believe that all people hold visible and invisible qualities that inherently make them unique, and we strive to create an inclusive culture where each person knows they are valued and belong."
