### Dianne Jacob County Supervisor

Supervisor Dianne Jacob was first elected to the Board of Supervisors in 1992. Now serving a seventh consecutive term, she has held elective office longer than anyone in San Diego County government history.

She represents the more than 620,000 residents of [District 2](#), a roughly 2,000-square-mile region that is the largest of the County's five supervisorial districts.

It includes the cities of El Cajon, La Mesa, Lemon Grove, Santee and Poway, along with the San Diego communities of Allied Gardens, College Area, Del Cerro, Grantville, Navajo, Rolando and San Carlos. She also represents East County's unincorporated communities, including Alpine, Julian, Ramona, Spring Valley, Campo and Rancho San Diego.

Dianne is a San Diego State University alumna and a native San Diegan whose roots run three-generations deep. She lives in Jamul.

She has earned a reputation over the decades as a tireless fighter for taxpayers, working to make County government more accountable to the public.

Spurred by a series of catastrophic wildfires in 2003 and 2007, she has led an ambitious effort to overhaul and beef up the region's [fire protection system](#). She has worked closely with law enforcement to combat human traffickers, sexual predators,
