## **Community Service - Good Neighbor Award**



David Harris is a resident of La Mesa, CA, and past president of the La Mesa Sunrise Rotary Club spoke to us today regarding new building projects and businesses coming to La Mesa. David serves on the City of La Mesa Planning Committee and is a community activist focusing on affordable housing. David spoke about the new neuro hospital that opened in April at Grossmont Hospital and the new Post Acute Care facility on the corner of Center Drive and Grossmont Center Drive. The projected opening of this facility is later this fall. Grossmont Center has a new owner and is in the first phase of remodeling and upgrading, a project with numerous phases over the next several years. TJ Maxx and Ulta are going in to the previous Toys R Us location.

Bank of America will be opening a new branch on November 14<sup>th</sup>. In & Out Burger will be moving into their old location. Soapy Joe's will be moving to the old Red Lobster location with 31 vacuum bays. In addition to the new In & Out Burger La Mesa will be getting several other new eateries. Bruster's Ice Cream shop will be opening on Fletcher Parkway at the Grossmont Trolley Center. Other new businesses recently opened or opening soon are Aromi Italian Cuisine, Aromi Pizza, J K's Greek Cuisine, Oodles noodle bar, Hacienda de Cazadores and Aromas de Indian. Aromas de Indian has robots to bring the food to the table with servers there to put it on your table.

There are three new housing projects on the docket. 8181 Allison is a new complex offering 1- and 2-bedroom apartments for those with moderate income. 73 townhouses will be built on Jericho Road and Amaya, and a new apartment complex is close to completion at our old home, the La Mesa Woman's Club.
