## **Good Shepherd Ministry Center**



We were privileged to have Susan Naslund, of the Good Shepherd Ministry Center, as our speaker today. The Good Shepherd Ministry Center located at 772 S. Johnson; El Cajon is a Foothills Methodist Church program with the goal of cultivating a place of health and peace with many vital programs serving the community.

The ministry center continues to hold a weekly Food Pantry each Saturday, gathers clothes for their Clothes Closet, provides diapers for babies, and free Yoga classes each Wednesday at 3 PM. The ministry has started the Shepherd's Spa, which dispenses full size shampoo, soap, etc.

The need is growing; they provide food for 300 folks each Saturday. Six years ago, they developed the Rescue Food project. The local grocery stores donate food they can't sell because the veggies aren't perfect, or the packaging is slightly damaged. Last year the Food Pantry received 47,000 pounds of food in this program.

The ministry center provides English as A Second Language Program and UCSD Health provides a clinic every other Saturday.

They are fortunate to have 200 volunteers. 20 of the 30 volunteers that work each Saturday are high school students. A scholarship program was developed for these student volunteers. This year 2 student volunteers received a \$1000 scholarship for college.
