The requirements for a request are listed below. Keep in mind, in the event of more requests than funds available, requests will be prioritized based upon meeting ALL requirements.

The requirements for a proper submission:

- Charity must be a 501(c)(3)
- Amount of request can not be greater than \$1,000
- A letter from the charity stating what the funds will be used for
- A sponsoring letter from you, the Rotarian, that explains your affiliation with the charity and why we as a club should support the charity
- A person from the charity must be able to make an appearance at a club meeting to be presented with the donation
