

REQUIREMENTS FOR A PROPER SUBMISSION:

Request must be accompanied with a letter the Club member sponsoring, specifying why the Foundation should consider the Grant request.

A letter from the Charity specifying on how they plan on utilizing the funds requested.

The Charity must be a 501(c)(3).

Amount of request cannot be greater than \$1,000 per Rotary fiscal year (July 2020-June 2021).

The Charity's Federal Tax ID Number and their California Tax Exempt number.

The Charity must be able to make an appearance at a Club meeting to make a presentation and receive the Grant check.

The more information provided by the Charitable Organization on how the funds will be utilized, the more likely the Grant will be approved.
