La Mesa City Hope is a community focused organization that serves the San Diego Region by developing and implementing strategies to address a variety of under-met or hard to meet needs in the community. Specifically, issues such as trauma, domestic violence, human trafficking, homeless resource connection, financial, literacy, communication/ social skills, etc.

City hope trains compassionate volunteers, equips them with information and resources, and places them where they can bring hope and help into traumatic situations.

City Hope is a 501(C)(3) that engages community collaboration to facilitate resilience and wellness. Through collaboration with First Responders and local schools, City Hope:

- Dispatches a crisis response team to aid in critical incidents
- Deploys trained domestic violence advocates to assist individuals and families affected by domestic violence
- Delivers resources to assist in meeting urgent needs
- Devises strategies in collaboration with key city leaders to positively impact our community and address

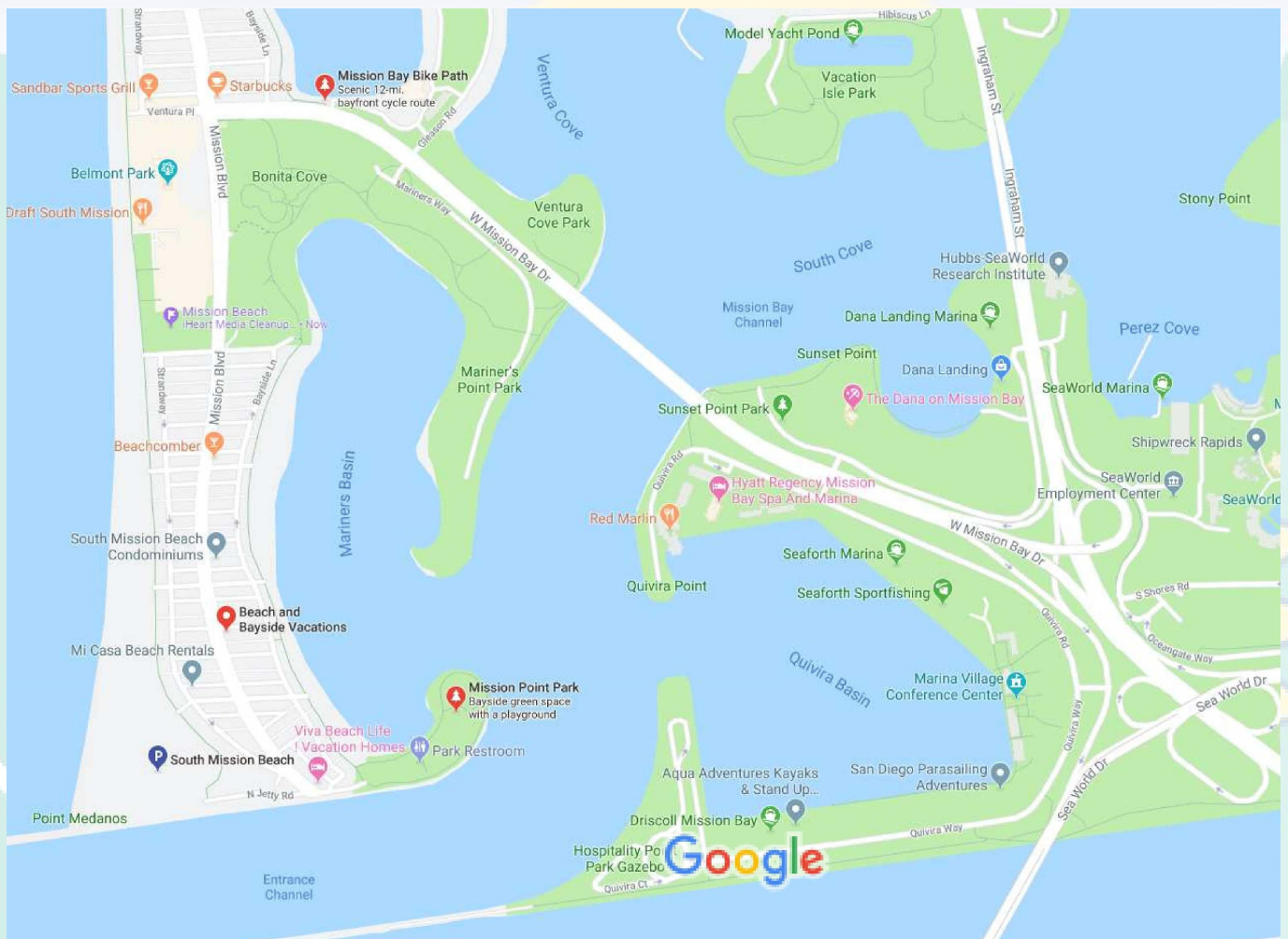
