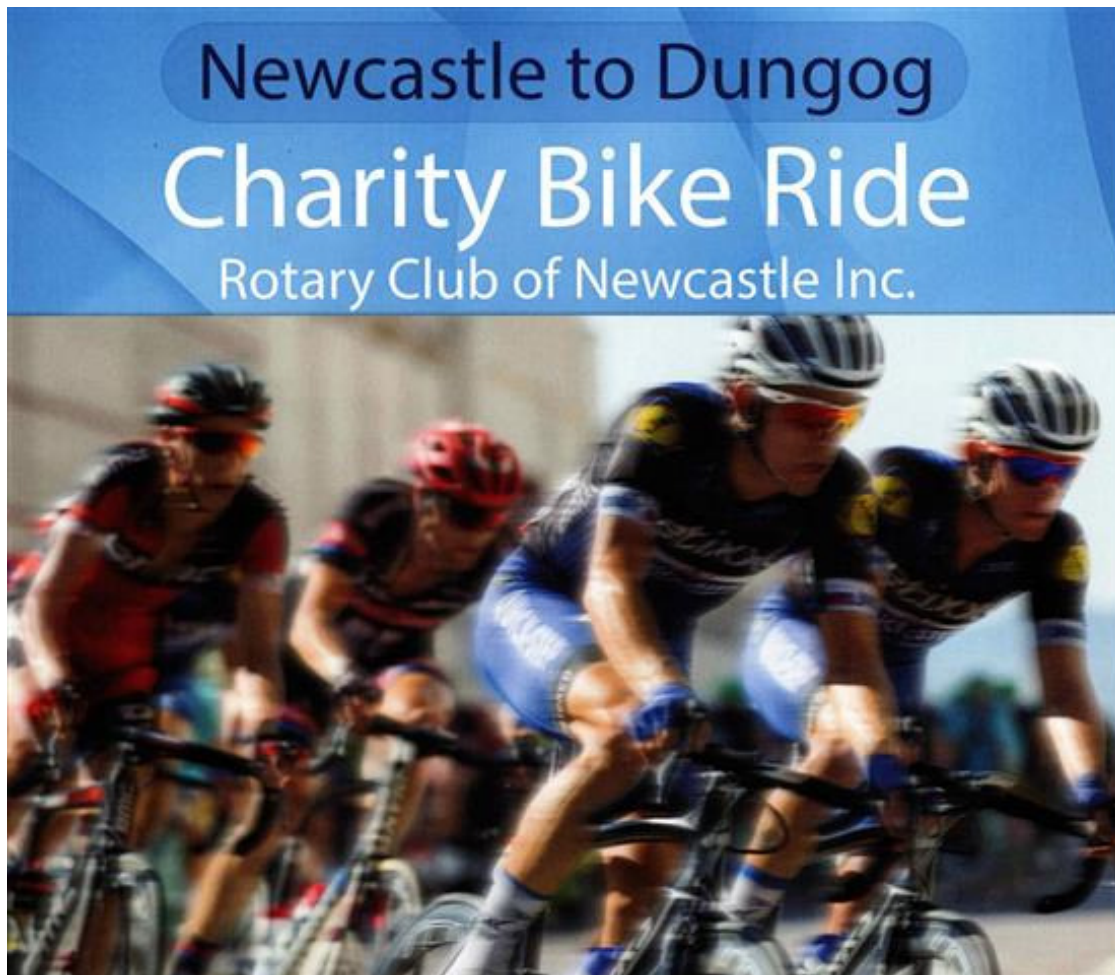

CLUB CHALLENGE TO ALL BIKE RIDERS – Newcastle to Dungog

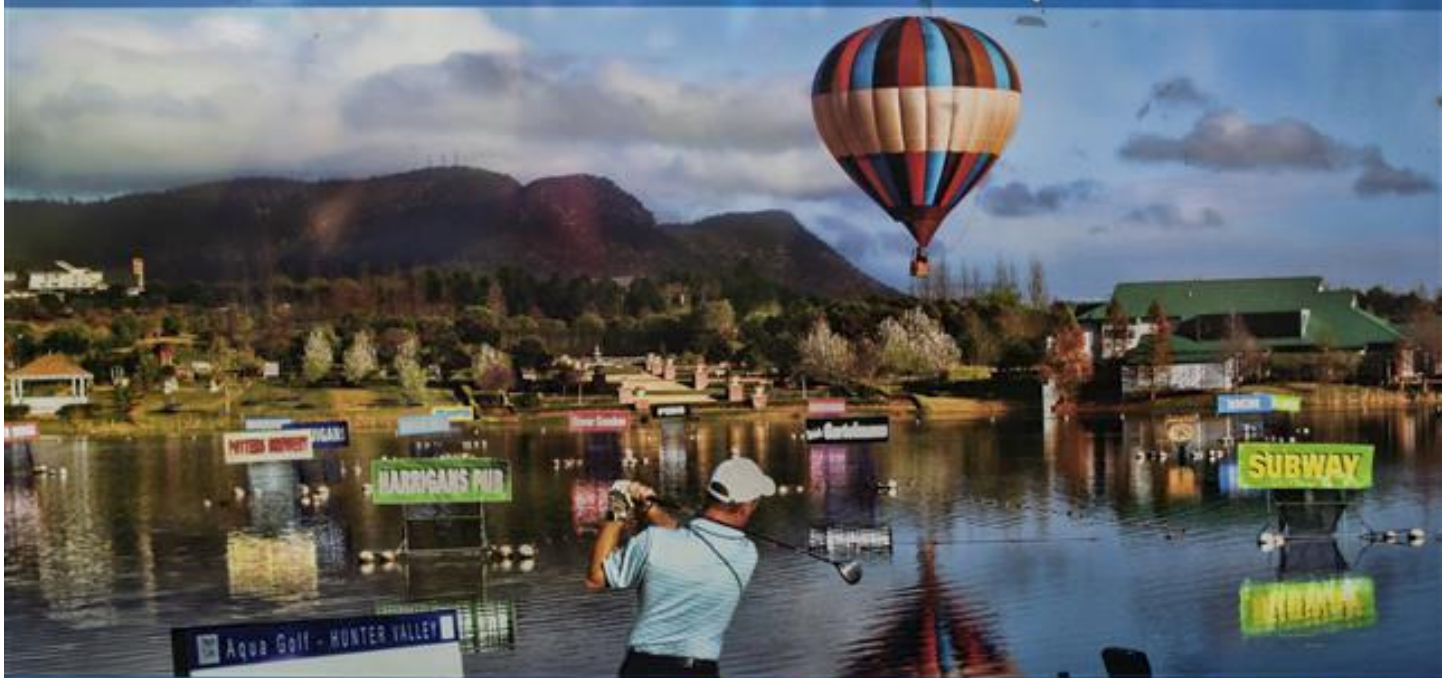

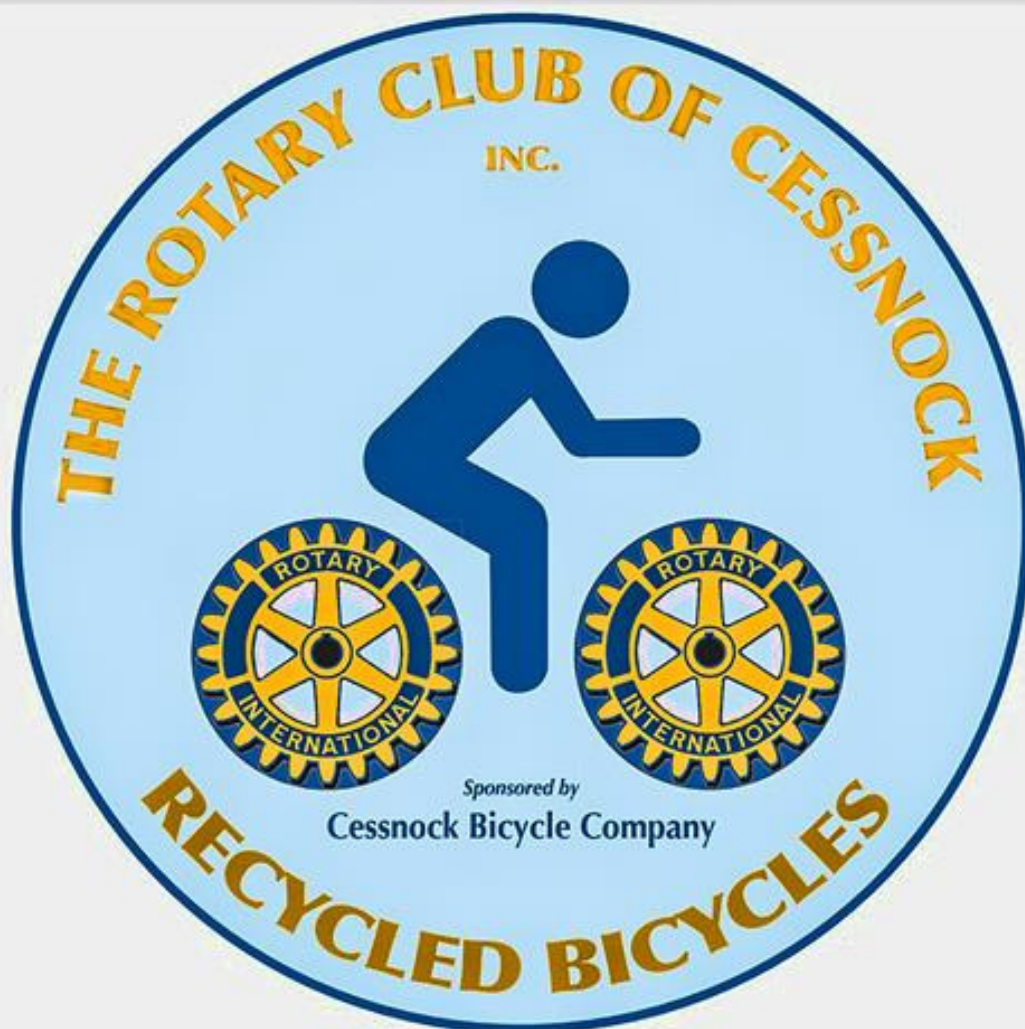

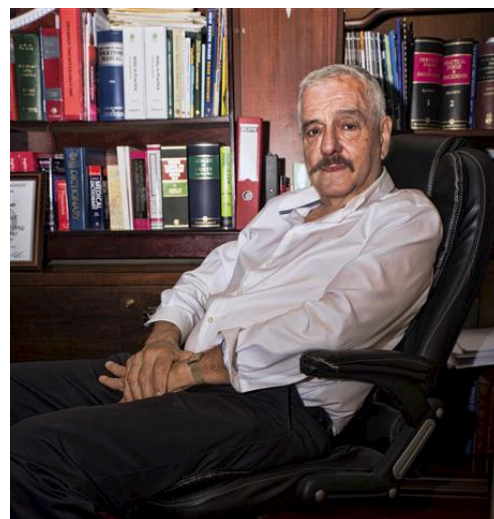
