Rotary can collect and put to good use

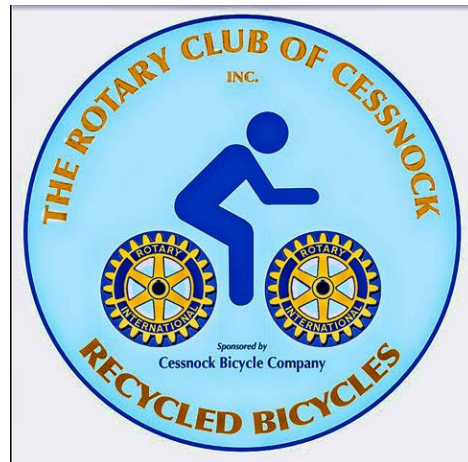
- We fix up donated bikes and give to those kids in need of a bike

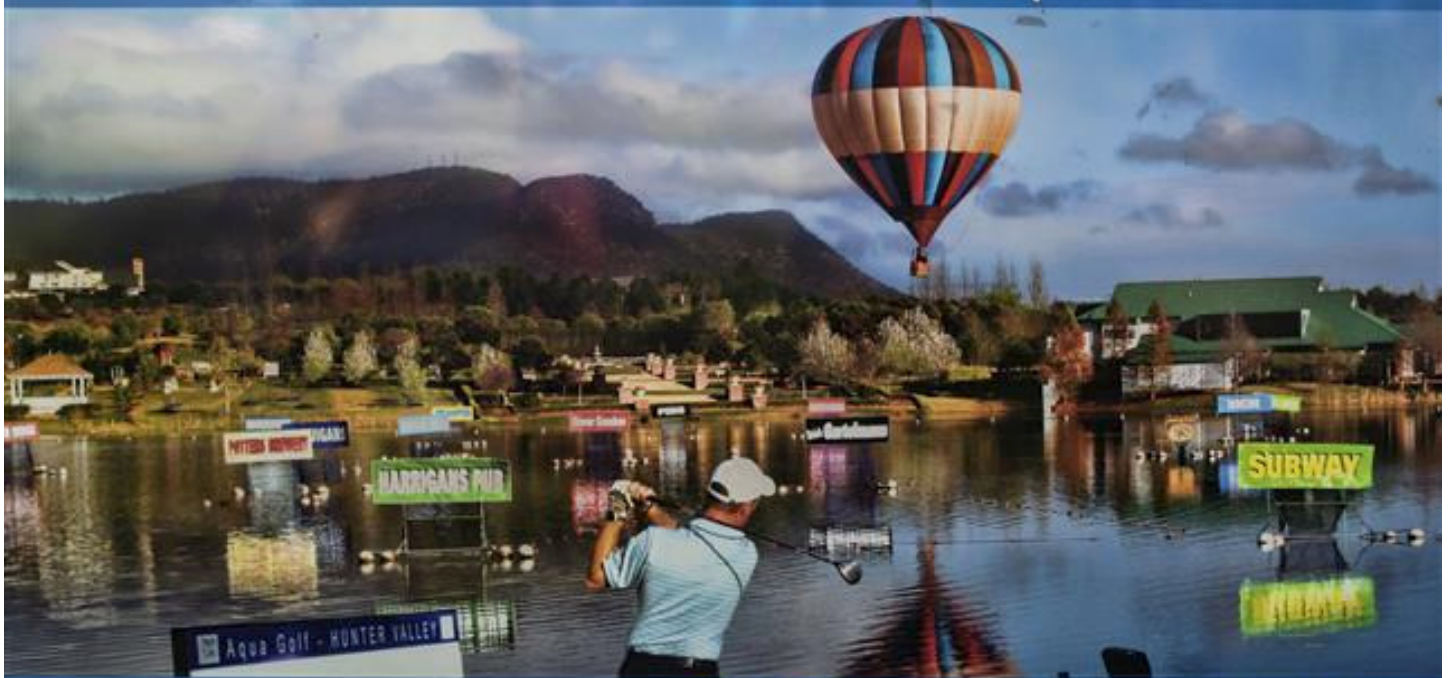

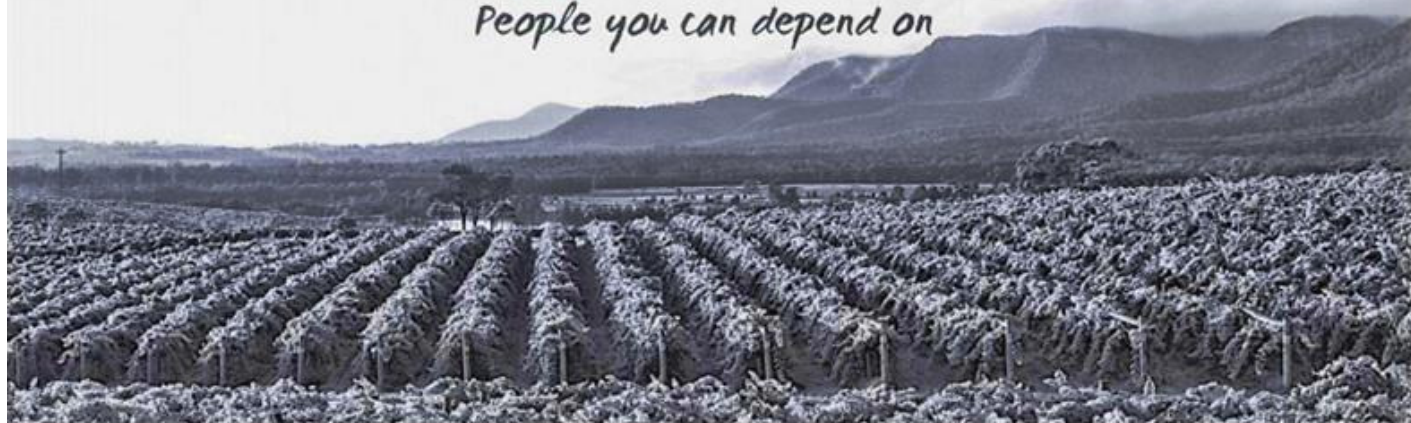
