## PRESIDENTS REPORT

It was also my last night as your President. In reviewing the year past it was instructive for me to read the first Message as President that George presented to us in the Spoke. I commented that "we must now move onto this year and build on all the learning's of the past with a view of continuing to satisfy the needs of our significant and demanding community whilst also being mindful of each others needs which must similarly be satisfied".

As I outlined to you on Thursday night the commitment to the needs of our community have continued significantly even with a reduced income resulting from the loss of the Vintage Golf day. Immediate Past President Gail was kind enough to analyse the community contributions our club has made which totalled approximately \$24,000.

In addition to this was the money set aside form last year and the Foundation Grant for the East Cessnock Healthy lifestyle Garden project totalling approximately \$22,000. Our club also contributed to Trish Davies Teacher Assist Kakoda RAWCS PNG project.

This analysis however only highlights the monetary value of our contribution. The value to the community and recipients of these funds far exceeds the dollar value and is measured not in mathematical terms but rather in the value of lives changed as a consequence of our giving. Each member should be proud of their individual efforts during the year and the club for the synergistic output of its members. John F Kennedy once reflected "We must find time to stop and thank the people who make a difference in our lives". When reflecting on the past year of our great Rotary Club of Cessnock's history, let us reflect on how many people we made a difference to in their lives. 
