Peter is very passionate in his dealings with climate change and how Rotary could maybe help the islands of Kiribati to be more sustainable with the introduction of methods to produce oil from the copra to offset the use of diesel fuel. Copra sales are being forced down by the market trend and the price of diesel is escalating. If the copra can produce enough oil fuel this would alleviate the necessity to purchase the high priced diesel. This in time leads to a more self sufficient economy, copra becomes a sought after product, employment for farming and in the production of the copra oil, less diesel to be imported. A very interesting talk from Peter.
