- Just to let you know that on the recommendation of the RLI Team, the Committee of the Association (COTA) has resolved that RLI training costs will be only partly subsidised by District from 1 July 2017. Participants will be invoiced \$75, which is only part of what it costs to run RLI. Those running costs include licence fees, participant resources and training materials, lunches and tea breaks. Rotarians who have a part, or parts, of RLI outstanding to complete their course will be invoiced \$20 per part. The District RLI Team recommends that Clubs pay for their participating members as an investment in strengthening their Club.
