




#### President's Report

This weekend course is held at our <u>District</u> <u>Office</u>, Thornleigh. Morning teas and lunches are provided.

Each day starts at 8:00 for 8:30am and finishes around 3.30 - 4.00 pm.

Just to let you know that on the recommendation of the RLI Team, the Committee of the Association (COTA) has resolved that RLI training costs will be only partly subsidised by District from 1 July 2017. This action is designed to add value to the course and ameliorate the losses when nominees for courses are unable to attend at the last moment. Participants will be invoiced \$75, which is only part of what it costs to run RLI. Those running include licence costs participant resources and training materials, lunches and tea breaks. Rotarians who have a part, or parts, of RLI outstanding to complete their course will be invoiced \$20 per part. The District RLI Team recommends that Clubs pay for their participating members as an investment in strengthening their Club.


