SA BOATING AND FISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLY

Carp are NOT permitted to be returned to the water

Registration online in advance or from 6:30am Saturday 4th of October at the Carp-A-Thon headquarters at Bristow Smith Reserve Barrage Road Goolwa.

COMPETITION START: 7am Saturday 4th of October and finishes at 3pm on that day.

- Entry Fees are outlined on event posters, online and on the registration form
- All Competitors must register in person at the Carp-A-Thon headquarters at Bristow Smith Reserve on the day of the competition and receive their ID wrist band and carp disposal bag. Please keep your band on, no band, no prize.
- Registration and payment is an agreement to the rules and regulations
- PLEASE do not return carp to the water (it is an offense to do so) after your Carp measurements have been taken, they will be disposed of at our Carp disposal station.
- MAXIMUM of two rods per person and no more than two hooks per rod
- Spear fishing is NOT permitted
- Any Native Fish caught, please follow local fishing regulations regarding and size

PRESENTATIONS: held at Bristow Smith Reserve Goolwa at 4pm

- There are two prize categories, U10 and adults
- You need to be present at the presentations to collect any eligible prizes
- You must have your ID Band on - No ID, no Prize
