Specifically, four Oceti Sakowin professionals from the United States will travel to Rotary District 9705 in New South Wales, Australia to visit Wiradjuri indigenous people, in October of 2024, ending after the D9705 conference October 25-27. This project will also educate Rotarians in the two districts about the cultures of their indigenous neighbors. A major goal is to build relationships and friendships between and among indigenous people and Rotarians. Rotarian team leader Kibbe Brown will travel and be embedded with the team to facilitate connections.

#### What do I need to do to be a team member?

Team member candidates must:

- Be currently employed for at least two years in any recognized business or profession on a full-time basis and be 25 to 40 years of age at the time of application
- Work or live in the tribal reservations or communities with significant native populations
- Be citizens of the United States and reside within the D5610 boundaries (see <u>rotary5610.org</u> for more information)
- Be able to respond to the question: How do/will you share your vocation/skills with your Native American community?
- Make presentations regarding yourself, your culture, and area of expertise to gatherings in Australia and make presentations to groups in South Dakota on your return from Australia.
- Do you currently have a valid passport? (Is not required in order to participate in application process).

Failure to comply with team member eligibility criteria can lead to misunderstandings and last-minute changes in the GSE team's composition. Contact the **GSE Team steering committee** or team leader Kibbe Brown as soon as possible with any questions about these conditions.

You will need to be able to handle international travel during the exchange, and active participation in regular training activities before the exchange, with your team members, and **you must also be** 

- In good health
- Neat in appearance and able to express yourself clearly and logically
- Interested in and clearly enthusiastic about your chosen vocation, and possess outstanding vocational skills
- Open-minded, tolerant, and flexible
- Able to travel for 2.5 weeks with your employer's consent
- Able to receive a visa to the host country or already have one
- Able to depart from the same location and on the same date as the rest of the team
- Able to identify as Native American through enrollment or lineage

### Team member recruitment

Team members will be responding to email, social media and word of mouth information and need to complete the application provided. Rotary clubs of District 5610 will be encouraged to support potential team members from within their local communities. (see Rotary Club Supporting Statement).

A selection committee that will include both Rotarians and representative of Oceti Sakowin will review applications to decide on next steps, namely an interview and reference checks. You may append additional information to the application that you believe the selection committee should take into account to make an informed decision on your selection status.
