

Rapid City Rotary Club Projects Support, 2013-15 Review

Community Projects:

Storybook Island - original founders of the park, providing ongoing support financially with member sponsorships, labor at lighting decorations, cleanup spring and fall, fall festival support. Board, marketing and promotion support. Tree replacement grant \$2400. Security system grant \$2000. Happy bucks, birthday dollars, Queen of Hearts drawings est. \$1500-2000 each year.

Journey Museum Education grant - \$10,000 project to provide classes to under-privileged children, teaching history, literacy and science. Members donate time at classes and fundraisers planning. Basketball books 2 years of fundraisers \$2400 and \$2050
Culinary Journey Indian dinner fundraiser \$1800

Cheyenne River Youth Project - toy drive, \$250-600

Lakota Children Enrichment - Scarsdale NY Rotary club project - \$500

Children's Home Society - participate in Rushmore club's golf and gala fundraisers

North Middle School - Washington DC trip support \$250
