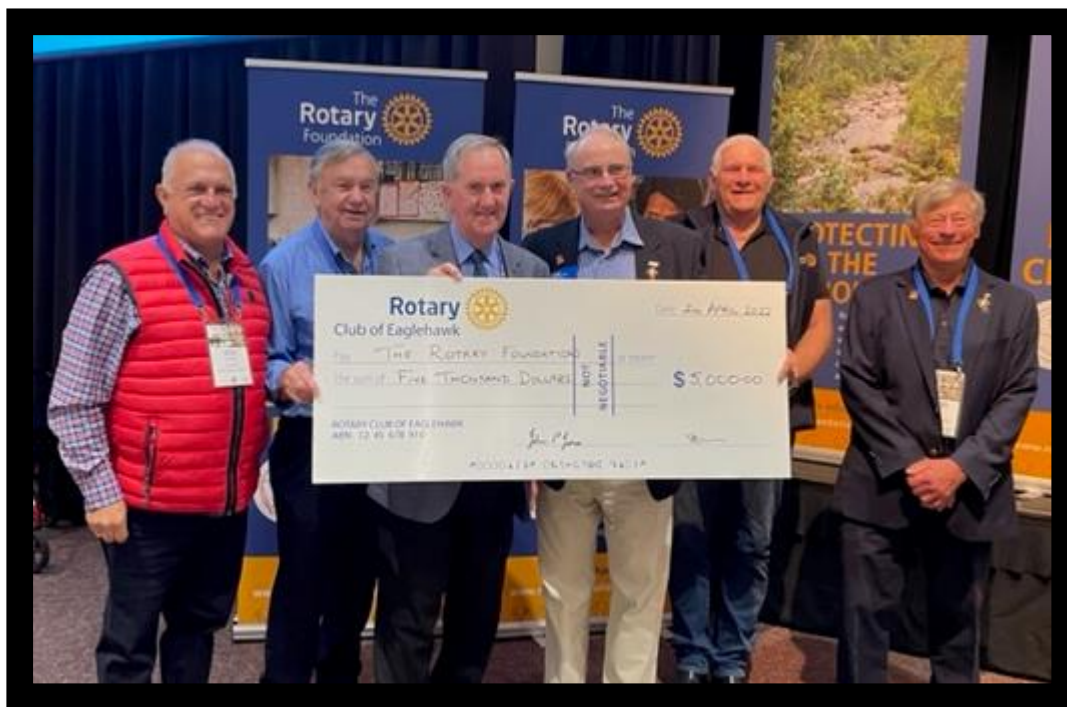

Club Meeting Happenings

Our guest speaker this week was [Sandra Slatter](#), the founder of the O'Keefe Challenge which will be held on Sunday May 1. The O'Keefe Challenge is a major fundraiser for the Heathcote Dementia Alliance which was established in 2014 and became incorporated in 2021. The challenge is comprised of a 5 km, 10 km, half marathon and full marathon and involves a wide range of community groups. Last year the Challenge raised \$6,500.

Why? Dementia is the second biggest killer of women. The alliance is managed by a board of five with support from a wide range of community groups and an expert advisory group. They have acquired a seventeen acre site and plans are well advanced. The purpose of the group is to, as much as possible, keep people out of aged care. They have had generous support from Mandalay Resources who engaged an architect for the program. It comprises flexible relocatable accommodation in clusters of eight. A similar program is being established in Merbein.

The presentation was testament to the detailed planning undertaken and the establishment of partnerships across all sectors – an incredibly innovative initiative.
