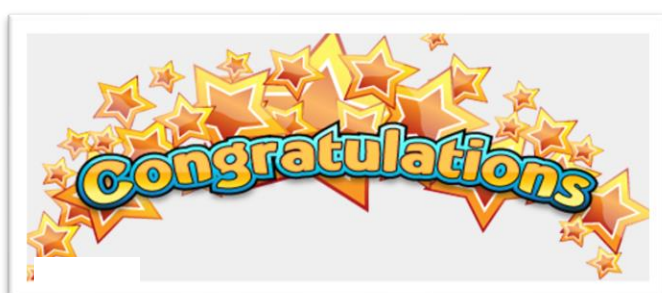

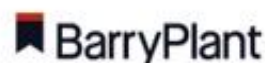

15. SERVICE	I help and benefit others in whatever way I can.
16. COURAGE	I accept responsibilities and challenges with calm determination.
