**AMBROSE SCORING & RULES** Four players (4 person ambrose) work as a team. Each player hits off the tee, the best shot is selected and all other players pick up their ball and

place it, within one handspan. alongside the best ball. Each person then hits a second shot rom the same spot. The best shot is again selected . This continues until the ball is in the hole. On the putting green the best ball is marked and the other balls are played from this position.

One score is thus recorded on each hole. This is the sum of the best shots used throughout the hole. The best shot from the team is chosen for each shot hence your group has four chances to hit a good shot.

If your best ball is played from within a hazard then each of the player's balls must be played from within that hazard.
