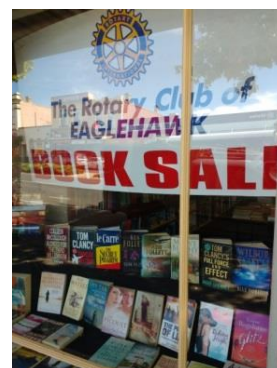

Map of Clubs in District

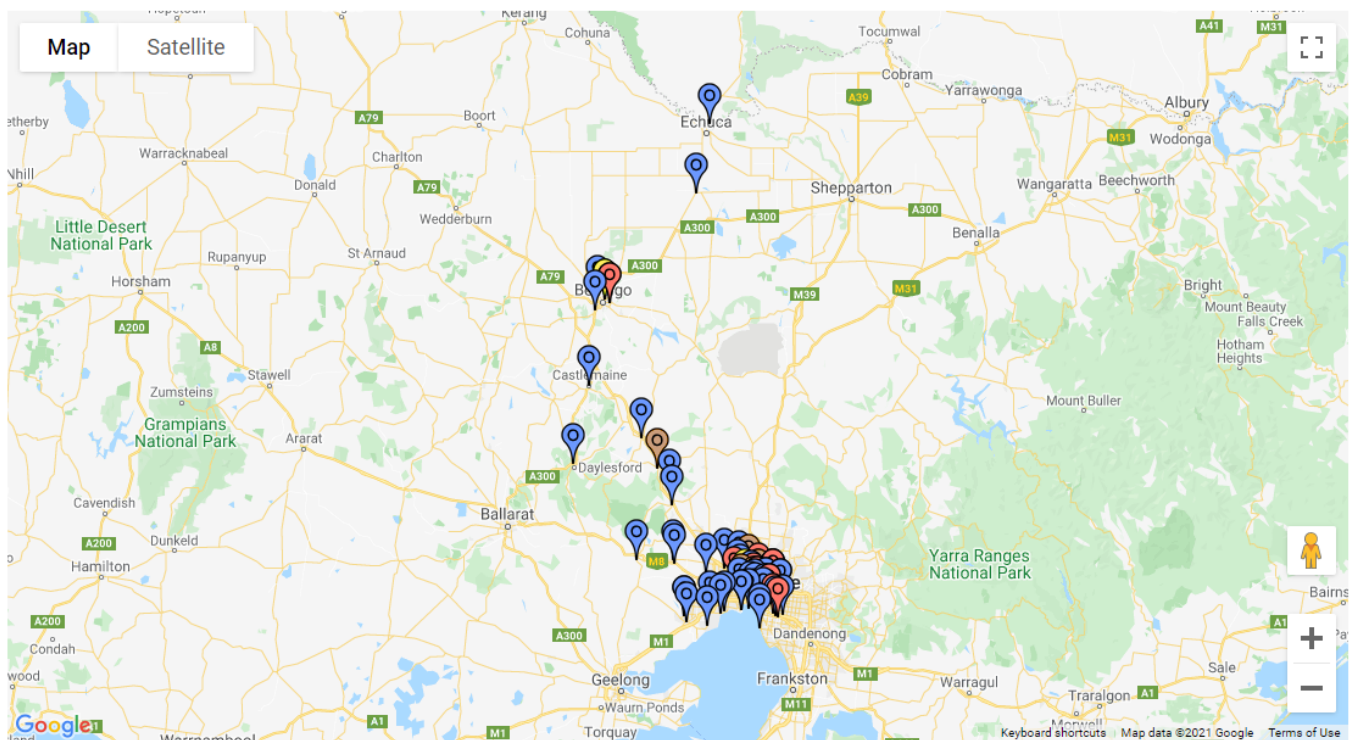
