NBN

connecting all Australians



At our Monday meeting this week, Ashley Merrett, our NBN in WA community ambassador (at left) gave us the facts on the \$50 billion roll-out of the “national broadband network.” It is a communication network that will—ultimately—give almost every Australian with the right digital device and the right service plan, reliable 24/7, communication ability.

The National Broadband Network, or NBN for short, is a high speed broadband network that’s being rolled out by the Australian Government owned NBN (formerly NBN Co.) The NBN is in charge of providing highspeed broadband connections to every home and office in Australia. It is also giving telephone and internet service providers’ access to the NBN so they can deliver services like telephony, entertainment, security and e-health to homes and businesses.

To make this happen, the NBN is using a range of broadband technologies, including Fibre to the premises or FTTP; Fibre to the building or FTTB; Fibre to the node or FTTN; HybridFibre Coax (HFC) (more commonly known as Pay TV cable); Fixed wireless; and Satellite.

The delivery of the NBN service to households, business organizations, institutions and allowed receivers is the responsibility of authorised retail telephone and internet service providers, such as Telstra, Optus, Vodaphone and many others ... in fact, by over 200 providers! So it’s up to the users - that includes you and me—to get the right plan and best value **and to review it regularly!**
