## AUSTRALIAN ROTARY HEALTH Indigenous Health Scholarship Program



At our Monday meeting this week, Ashlee Bence spoke with passion about her direct involvement with this amazing program.

The program is a jointly funded initiative between

Rotary Clubs, State Governments and the Australian Government. The aim is to establish a scholarship fund that can be used for assisting indigenous Australian students studying nursing, medicine and allied health.

The purpose of the program is to increase the number of indigenous Australian medical staff and by so doing, improve the health of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in rural and remote areas of Australia where access to basic preventative medical treatment is often difficult.

Ashlee spoke about the importance that indigenous medical professionals have in working with the aboriginal community to ensure that culturally appropriate care and assistance is given.



Ashlee is a scholarship recipient, sponsored by the Matilda Bay Rotary Club, she was an intensive care nurse and in 2016 made a decision to change course and train to become a dentist. She will fulfil this goal and become a dentist in a few short months.

Ashlee's address to our Club elicited a pledge that Rotary Wanneroo would contribute \$2500 this calendar year (2019/20) to the program.
