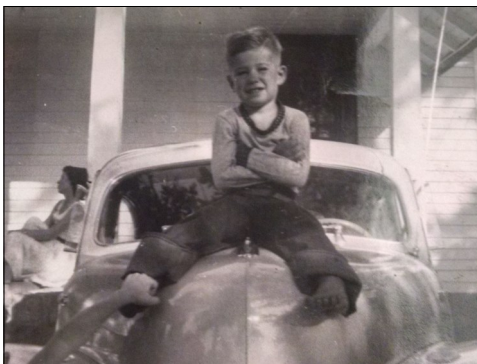

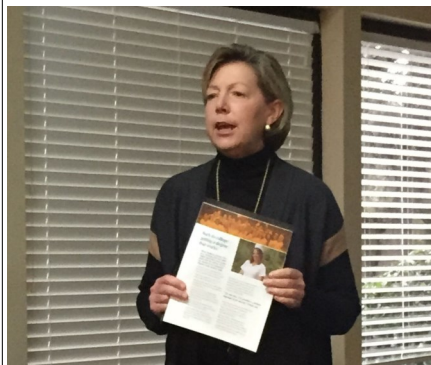

Chief Reece Bertholf was born and raised in Minnesota. Upon graduation from high school in 1997, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps, attending Recruit Training at MCRD San Diego and completed Combat Engineer School in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina by the spring of 1998. While still in the Marine Corps he began volunteering with the City of Beaufort Fire Department in May of 2000. Upon receiving an honorable discharge from the Marine Corps in August of 2001, he started his career with City of Beaufort and was assigned to Shift 1 and worked his way through the ranks obtaining the rank of Captain in September 2011. He holds an Associate's Degree in Business and an Associate's Degree in Fire Service Administration from the Technical College of the Lowcountry, a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of South Carolina Beaufort, and a Master's Degree in Business Administration from the Citadel. He is a 4 time recipient of the City of Beaufort Lifesaving medal for direct involvement in rescues from the Beaufort River, an autistic child stuck over 35 feet in the air in a tree, a severely injured police officer, and victims of heart attacks who survived as a result of CPR. He is married to his wife Mikie and they have two children, Kiwa and Kai.
