## Rotary Foundation August Fun Fact

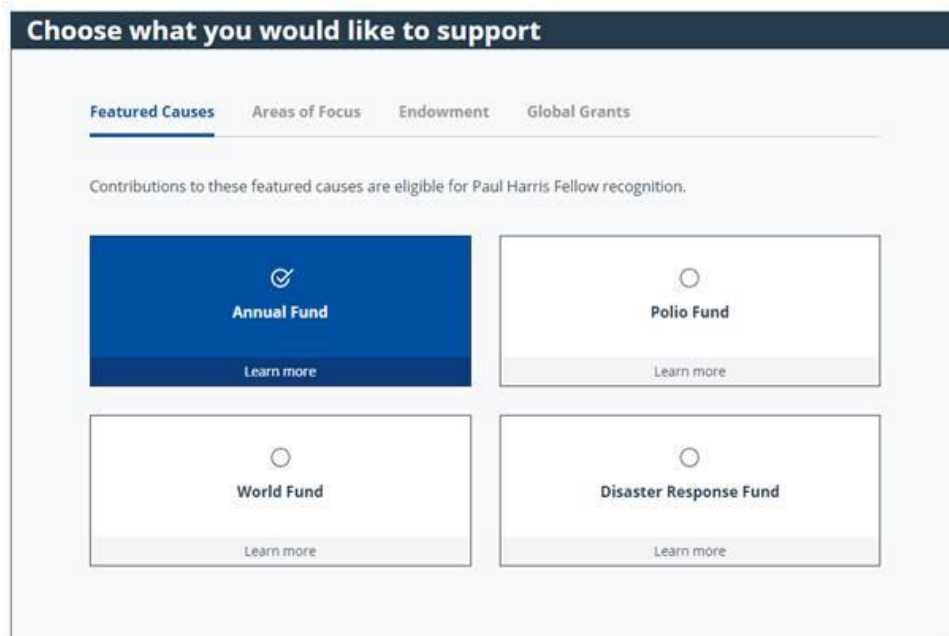


Did you know that you can direct your Rotary Foundation donation to an area that's important to you?

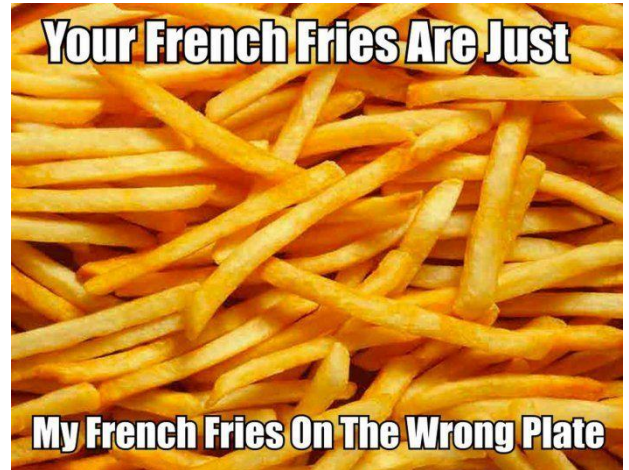
