## 'tis the season ... for the ever-popular ... Christmas trivia!

"Jingle Bells" was composed in 1857 by James
Pierpont, originally called "One Horse Open Sleigh" and written as a Thanksgiving Song. (At the original Thanksgiving, there was no milk, cheese, bread, butter, mashed potatoes, corn, pumpkin pie, turkey, or spoons.)
The first Christmas card was created in England on December 9, 1842.

•Franklin Pierce was the first United States' president to decorate an official White House Christmas tree during his term 1853-1857.

•Electricity was installed in the White House in 1891. Three years later (1894), during the presidency of Grover Cleveland, electric lights first appeared on a White House Christmas Tree. The lights were red, *white*, & blue.
