1792 24 merchants form New York Stock Exchange at 70 Wall Street.
1875 1st Kentucky Derby: Oliver Lewis aboard Aristides wins in 2:37.75.
1883 Buffalo Bill's 1st Wild West show opens in Omaha, Nebraska.
1932 US Congress changes name "Porto Rico" to "Puerto Rico."
1939 1st televised baseball game is broadcast on NBC, with Princeton defeating Columbia 2-1.
1954 US Supreme Court unanimously rules on Brown v Topeka Board of Education - reverses 1896 "separate but equal" Plessy v Ferguson.
1969 Russian probe Venera 6 landed on Venus. (Moon landing - July, 1969)
1973 Senate Watergate Committee begins its hearings.
2007 Trains from North and South Korea cross the 38th Parallel in a test-run agreed by both governments. This is the first time that trains have crossed the Demilitarized Zone since 1953.
