Doyou remember watching Neil Armstrong take that "One small step for mark" I remember our family watching it on our giant, black & white, floor console, TV that lived in the basement because it was so big. The discussion we were having as we watched Neil descend the lunar module's ladder to take that small step was whether Dad's 35 mm. Retina camera would capture the images on the Kodachrome slide film or whether the film would return from processing without any image at all.

Our particular TV set had a strange feature – one that I have never seen since – that was when it was turned on, a plastic frame (think like the plastic-covered lights on either side of an old-style medicine cabinet's mirror), which surrounded the tube, would light up. [I think it night have been a feature to tell the dunder-heads of the family that the TV was left on and eating up the electricity...like we wouldn't notice the static picture that filled the screen following the playing of the National Anthem as the flag weved]. We determined that if the film could not capture the TV image, it would certainly capture the lighted border.

Dad had never tried to take a picture of the television screen when the TV was turned on so we speculated as to whether the electro-magnetic field or beams of light emitted by the tube would interfere with capturing the still photo or not. Oh, we were scientifically sophisticated in our thinking!

I think that roll of filmmight have been the most anticipated one of my childhood. We wanted to see if "Mankind's giant leap" had been captured by Dad's camera. It had been — with the lighted border and all! I haven't seen that picture for 50 years, but I know it's somewhere among the tens of thousands of slides my father took to document a lifetime of experiences.
