9 November at the United Nations Secretariat in New York City.
Registration is NOW OPEN!!

Due to increasingly tight security measures, the UN has limited the number of rooms it permits for civil society/ general public events – particularly during the period of the UN General Assembly which runs from September through December. Regrettably, there is no longer sufficient "UN-authorized" space for two programs. We will instead include Rotaractors and other young professionals in our one UN Day program. In keeping with the above decision, we are limiting event participation to age 18 and over.

District 7390 has reserved a 55 passenger deluxe motor coach to transport attendees to the United Nations Day. Exact departure and return times have not been established. However, if you would like to attend the UN day, you can reserve your seat on the bus NOW! Seats will be reserved on a first come, first served basis.

The cost is \$50 per person to reserve a seat on the bus.

Admission to the UN day is \$75 for those over the age of 35, and \$50 for those age 18 to 35.

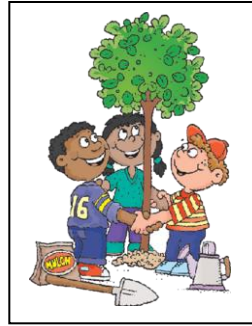

Meet at E-town Church of the Brethren at 8:45 for work assignments.

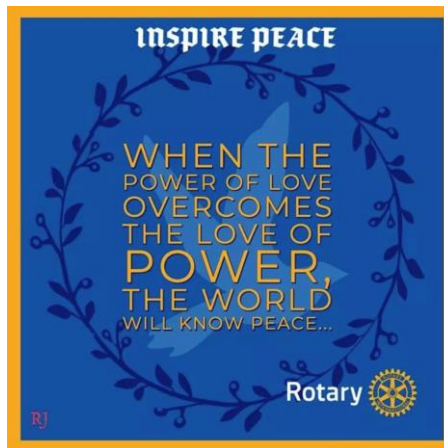
Tree planting will also be taking place sometime in **late September or Early October.**
