The fear of Friday the 13th combines separate bad-luck associations with the number 13 and the day Friday making for one super unlucky day.

- Norse myth 12 gods having a dinner party at Valhalla (heaven). In walked the uninvited 13th guest, Loki. Once there, Loki arranged for Hoder, the blind god of darkness, to shoot Balder the Beautiful, the god of joy and gladness, with a mistletoe-tipped arrow. Balder died sending the Earth into darkness.
- 2) Biblical reference Judas was the 13<sup>th</sup> guest to the Last Supper. Traditionally believed that is was on a Friday that the following occurred: Eve tempted Adam with the apple, the Flood, the confusion at the Tower of Babel, and Jesus' crucifixion.
- 3) History Middle Ages, King Philip of France arrested the revered Knights Templar and began torturing them on Friday the 13th in 1306.
  - Space program unlucky mission of Apollo 13.
- 4) Capital Punishment British tradition held that Friday was the conventional day for public hangings with supposedly 13 steps leading up to the noose.
- 5) Superstition witches gathered in groups of 12. The 13th was the devil.
