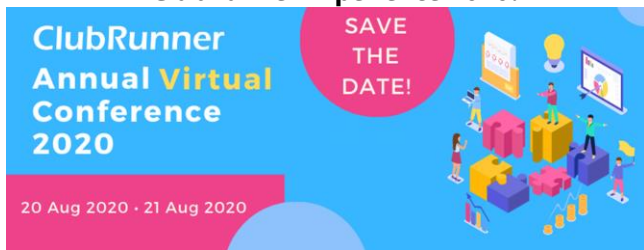

to the local food banks!

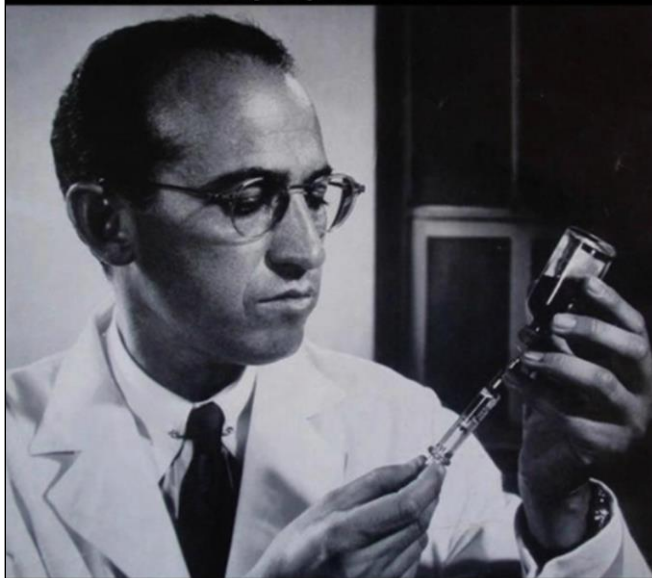
Where: The non-profit Wittel Farm
