












Elizabethtown Rotary Club's TASTE OF WESTERN LANCASTER COUNTY



"Michael Weber, Nuclear Reg. Commission Retiree, Historian & Author to Speak" GLORY DAYS OF THE CORNWALL MINE UNTIL ITS DEMISE IN 1973

Monday January 22, 2:00 PM - Keystone Room of the Buchanan Building, Masonic Village

Michael spoke to Rotary a few years ago about Three Mile Island and now will be providing an overview of the history of mining at the Cornwall mines. which produced about 106 million tons of iron ore from 1737 until 1973, as well as copper, silver, gold and cobalt. These were the largest iron mines in the United States until the 1880s and was one of the longest continually operated mines in the Western Hemisphere. Cornwall helped provide the raw materials for manufacturing artillery and munitions for the Revolutionary and Civil Wars.
