

What is the best program you've ever seen at Rotary? Without question the female Holocaust survivor. We scheduled the meeting 15 minutes early and 15 minutes late to give her enough time. You could hear a pin drop during her entire presentation. She was pulled off of a pile of naked dead bodies for mass burial. She couldn't move, but a British soldier noticed a slight pulse.
