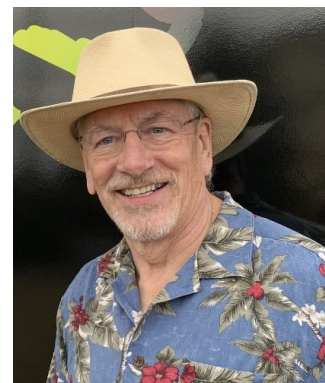

You could hear a pin drop during her entire presentation. She was pulled off of a pile of naked dead bodies for mass burial. She couldn't move, but a British soldier noticed a slight pulse.


