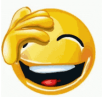

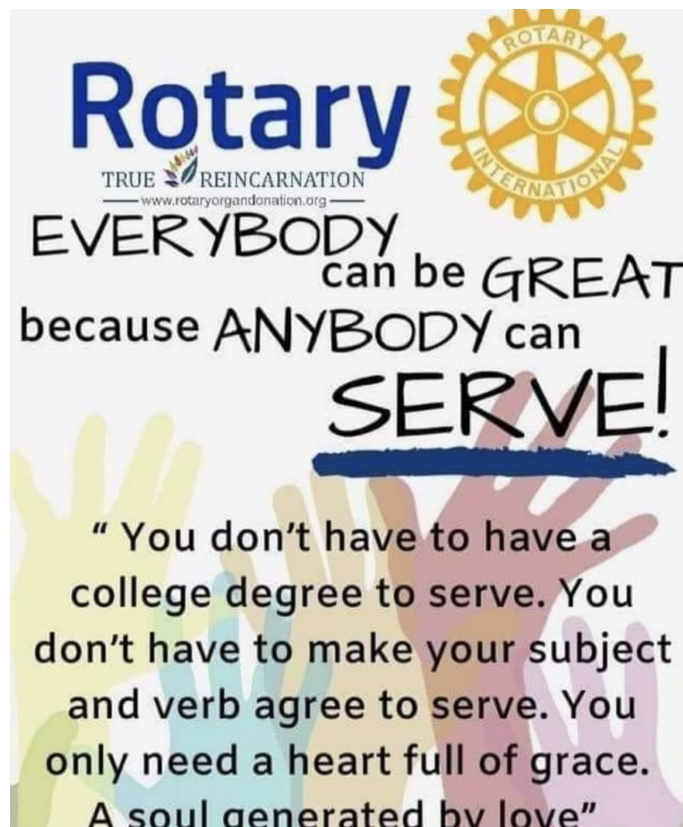

Rotary Student Loans Program - Applications for Students Loans are currently being accepted for the 2023-2024 School Year. Loans are available to high school graduates who reside within the territorial limits of the Rotary Club of Elizabethtown. Students should possess a good scholastic record, good character, motivation, participation in extracurricular activities and general good habits. Loans are made for one year at a time, but students are encouraged to reapply annually for additional loans. Loans are secured by a promissory note signed by the student and his/her parents. Applications are due by June 14 and are granted and paid in July. For more information on how to apply visit this link. [Student Loan Program](#)

PURPOSE: To encourage and assist undergraduate students to prepare themselves for advancement and to better serve society. Loans are available to high school graduates who reside within the territorial limits of the Elizabethtown Rotary Club as defined by Rotary International. (Note: Transient residents are not considered as eligible recipients.)

The student should possess a good scholastic record, good character, motivation, participation in extracurricular activities and good work ethic. In addition to submitting an application for assistance, high school applicants must also submit a Guidance Counselor recommendation, a Student Aid report and possess a GPA of at least 74. Applicants already enrolled in a college or technical school must submit a Student Aid report and transcript showing a GPA of at least 2.0.

Loans shall be restricted to those who cannot afford their college, university or technical education without financial assistance. Applicants may select the school of their choice, provided that the institution meets with the approval of the members of the Student Loan Committee. Application and loan disbursements are considered for only one academic year at a time. Applicants must reapply to continue any aide beyond one academic year. Each application will be considered separate of any prior application.

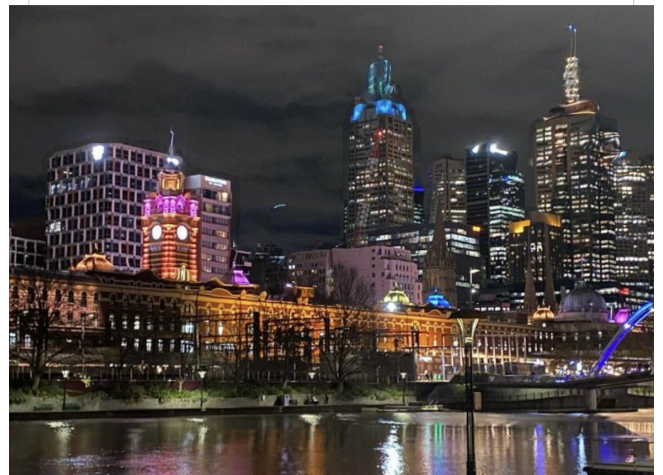

SUSTAINABILITY OF ROTARY FOUNDATION GRANT PROJECTS

Sustainability means different things to different organizations. For Rotary, sustainability means providing long-term solutions to community problems that community members themselves can support after the grant funding ends.

Global grant projects must be sustainable and should display the following characteristics:

- 1. Start with the community** - Identify a need and develop a solution that builds on community strengths and aligns with local values and culture.
- 2. Encourage local ownership** - Identify key community members who can help pioneer lasting improvements.
- 3. Provide training** - A project's success depends on people.
- 4. Buy local** - Purchase equipment and technology from local sources.
- 5. Find local funding** - Get local funding through governments, hospitals, companies, and other organizations.
- 6. Measure your success** - Develop clear and measurable project outcomes and determine how you will collect your data.
