ROTARY INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Don't miss this informative and entertaining speaker on Monday June 14.

Jeffry Cadorette retired from healthcare in 1999 after a 25-year career as a physical therapist. He had been President and CEO of Physical Therapy Associates of Delaware County in Pennsylvania until merging his practice with Riddle Memorial Hospital to form the Riddle Rehabilitation Institute and Riddle Sports Medicine. He now serves as Associate Broker and Executive Vice President at Media Real Estate Company where he is active in all phases of commercial real estate sales and leasing, tenant representation and new project development

He is a past Trustee on the Springfield College Board of Trustees and is a member of and Past Co-president of the Springfield College Philadelphia/Wilmington Alumni Association.

He served on the Board of Directors of the Rocky Run YMCA for 14 years, 4 as Chair of that Board. He was Honorary Chair of their Phase 11 and Phase 111 Capital Campaigns for Rocky Run.

He is a past Board member of the Philadelphia Freedom Valley Y where he was Chair of its Branch Operations Committee.

A Rotarian with the Rotary Club of Media, PA since 1977, Jeff served as Governor of District 7450 in 1998-1999. In September of 2016 he was the selection of the Zones 24/32 Nominating Committee for Director to serve on the Rotary International Board of Directors in 2018-2020.

Active in international service projects, he traveled to South America as part of a Rotary Foundation Matching Grant project to set up a Village Bank in Lima, Peru. Operating on the principles of micro-credit, it was a joint project of the Rotary Club of Media and the Rotary Club of El Rimac in Lima.

In October 1999, he spent 8 days in Madagascar participating in a polio NID which was the culmination of The Philadelphia Challenge, a fundraising effort he initiated during his year as Governor. He accompanied a team of 27 who made the trip from District 7450. The Philadelphia Challenge raised record dollars for The Rotary Foundation and allowed District 7450 to lead Zones 31 & 32 in every category of giving to The Rotary Foundation in 1998-99.

In December of 2003 he travelled to Yaroslavl, Russia to assist in fund development initiatives for their YMCA.

Dear Elizabethtown Rotarians:

There are several changes the board approved at the June board meeting with an effective date of July 1, 2021:

1. In the past (pre-COVID), members attending Friday meetings were billed in advance for their meals. If they missed a meeting, the funds were not returned to the member. The money was used for club operations. However, Monday attendees were on a pay-as-you-go basis, paying Mooduck for their drink. The board has determined that treating Friday and Monday attendees differently "Is not fair to all concerned". Therefore, beginning with the new Rotary year (7/1/2021), Friday attendees will also be on a pay-as-you go basis. Funk Brewing will collect the meal fee (\$13) from attendees each week.

2. The current dues fee is \$45/quarter (\$180/yr). Of that amount, approximately \$145 goes to Rotary International and Rotary District 7390. The remaining (less than \$35/year) stays with our club. The board has approved an amendment to our Club Bylaws increasing the dues to \$50/quarter (\$200/yr). The additional funds will go directly to our club to pay for administrative costs. We felt this was necessary due to the discontinuation of the Friday attendee pre-pay situation. The bylaw will read as follows:

***Purpose:** To raise the dues \$5/quarter, to make the billing \$50/quarter, or a total of a \$20 increase for the year to \$200. This will give the Club approximately \$2600 in revenue for additional administrative costs such as rent, software, accounting, postage, website, etc.*

Article 6 Dues and Fees

Annual club dues are \$200. They are paid quarterly. Annual club dues include RI per capita dues, a subscription to The Rotarian magazine, district per capita dues, club fees, and any other Rotary or district per capita assessment.

The bylaw change (#2) will require a club vote. This vote will take place at the meetings on **Monday, June 14th and Friday, June 18th**. We must have quorum for the vote.

Please plan to attend one of the meetings to ensure we have a quorum present.
