Remember, the restaurant is not open to the public for lunch.

The cost of the meal will remain at \$15. The menu will be changed often to avoid becoming monotonous. You will order from and pay your server. Please don't forget to tip!

Here is a sneak peek of the July 11th menu:

- BOURBON BACON BURGER: Our house made bourbon bacon jam topped fresh prime burger finished with a fried onion ring, bacon and cheddar cheese melted and served on a toasted roll with chips and pickles
- CHICKEN COBB SALAD: Grilled chicken breast on a bed of mixed greens with hardboiled egg slices, diced tomatoes, sweet corn, cheddar jack mixed cheese, and crispy bacon pieces served with choice of house Italian or our ranch dressing
- SMOKED PORK SANDWICH: House smoked pulled pork topped with our coleslaw and melted cheddar cheese served on a toasted roll with chips and pickles
- BUFFALO CHICKEN MAC N CHEESE: Grilled marinated chicken tossed in mild sauce (or on the side) on a bed of mac n cheese with bacon pieces, bleu cheese crumbles and scallions

Everything sounds delicious! I invite everyone to attend on the 11th for Denise's first Friday meeting as President (and every Friday) and give a hearty thanks to Hennigan's.


