Here is a sneak peek of the July 11th menu:

- **BOURBON BACON BURGER:** Our house made bourbon bacon jam topped fresh prime burger finished with a fried onion ring, bacon and cheddar cheese melted and served on a toasted roll with chips and pickles
- **CHICKEN COBB SALAD:** Grilled chicken breast on a bed of mixed greens with hardboiled egg slices, diced tomatoes, sweet corn, cheddar jack mixed cheese, and crispy bacon pieces served with choice of house Italian or our ranch dressing
- **SMOKED PORK SANDWICH:** House smoked pulled pork topped with our coleslaw and melted cheddar cheese served on a toasted roll with chips and pickles
- **BUFFALO CHICKEN MAC N CHEESE:** Grilled marinated chicken tossed in mild sauce (or on the side) on a bed of mac n cheese with bacon pieces, bleu cheese crumbles and scallions

Everything sounds delicious! I invite everyone to attend on the 11th for Denise's first Friday meeting as President (and every Friday) and give a hearty thanks to Hennigan's.


