PRESIDENT'S 2024-2025 GOALS

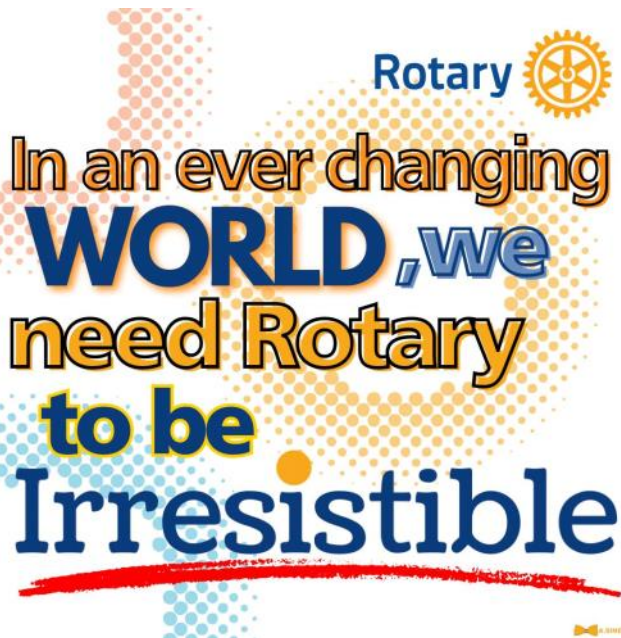
