Dr. Joe Rebman was right on track this year with daily Facebook posts highlighting our sponsors and the status of the tree sale.

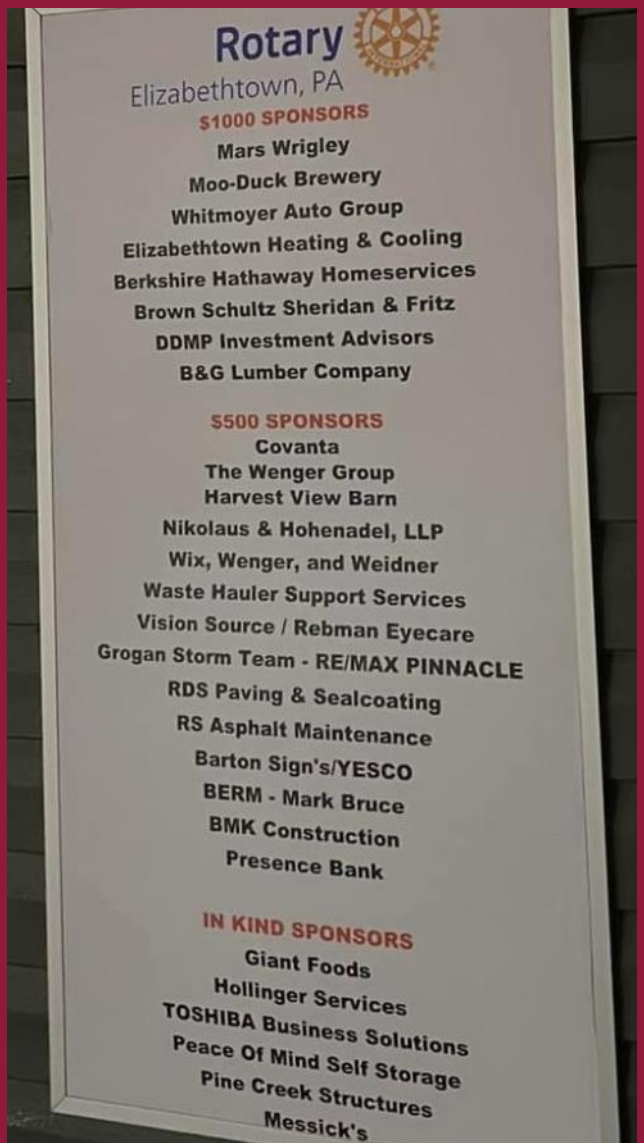
