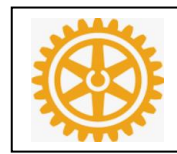


The SHARE Project (Serving Humanity & Re-Purposing Equipment)

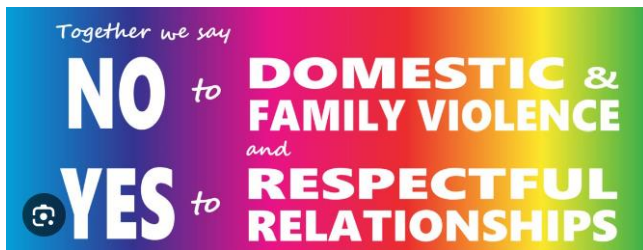
