The Duck Parade at Vergenoegd Wine Estate

How thousands of ducks can replace pesticide use on a farm

Vergenoegd Wine State in Stellenbosch has more than a thousand Indian Runner Ducks at the farm to assist in the control of the snail and pest population in their vineyards, a practice they have been refining since 1984. This waddling workforce is essential to the farm's pest-control, consuming a startling amount of snails and bugs on their daily patrols. The ducks are also a big part of why Vergenoegd proudly carries WWF biodiversity certification. They



also have a basic research and breeding program in place to keep the workforce of ducks productive, healthy and happy. Intrigued guests can take a tour of the duck pens and "breeding room" with Denzel, their duck farmer.


