## APPEAL: THE BOOKERY

*Please can you bring contributions to a Newlands Rotary Monday night meeting and give to Shân or Geraldine!*

The Bookery is registered NPO based in Cape Town. The organisation works in partnership with schools to establish libraries where there is not library or a non-functional library.

The Bookery is not concerned with establishing a school library and exiting immediately. Its focus is on establishing libraries in well-identified schools and then working with the schools to get the library to a high level of functionality that benefits everyone in the school. We believe strongly in collaborations and this includes involvement (come about through the UCT's School Development Unit) in a Language and Library Partnership that Rotary is also a member of.

There is a library assistant placed in 26 of the libraries we are involved in. A large part of their role is to work on making reading fun and getting learners to see the library as a place of learning and adventure. The library assistants therefore carry out many creative means of ensuring this. This includes reading clubs and literacy-related activities. For getting learners involved in making puppets, making their own books or other creative activities, the library assistants require materials. We like to keep this as low-cost as possible and to use as many recycled materials as possible. Because of this we would very much appreciate any of the following items: material scraps, ribbon, buttons, cotton (and needles), loo paper rolls, the six egg egg-boxes, colourful pipe cleaners, safety pins and paperclips. We have also given some library assistants 2 litre ice-cream bakkies and 1 litre yoghurt tubs as a cost-free ways for library assistants to store stationery etc and they have responded positively to these items and have asked for additional containers if possible.
