FREMONT – The Rotary Club of Fremont partnered with Fremont Ross High School again this year to provide a program called STRIVE for 18 high school seniors.

STRIVE stands for Students Taking a Renewed Interest in the Value of Education. Students participated in monthly meetings at the school and received support and information from Rotarians who served as mentors.

Students who most closely met their goals of improving attendance, attitude, grades, and participation were eligible for college scholarships.
