

Gannett Foundation donates \$5,250 to 2 local nonprofits

FREMONT - The Gannett Foundation, a corporate foundation sponsored by Gannett Co. Inc., has donated \$5,250 to two local charities as part of its semi-annual community grant program.

A grant of \$3,750 was awarded to the Fremont Rotary Club to promote literacy through a number of school-based programs in Sandusky County.

Community Support Services in Port Clinton (formerly Ottawa County Transitional Housing) received a foundation grant of \$1,500 to be used to assist homeless individuals and families in Ottawa County.

Gannett Foundation's community grants are awarded to nonprofit organizations in cities where the media company has daily newspapers. The News-Messenger in Fremont and the News Herald in Port Clinton are part of the Gannett/USA Today Network.
