Past District Governor, **Joe Kovarik**, has served Rotary District 5960 for the past 6-½ years in the leadership team. He is a dedicated St. Paul Rotarian who helps others achieve their goals for self-improvement, so they can be fulfilled as individuals and contribute more to any activity they choose to pursue. The District has a six-year succession plan and Joe will have officially served in all the roles of the district leadership team including District Governor in 2013-2014.

Some of his career highlights include teaching at a high school in Chicago, then moving to a community college in Minnesota, to various businesses across the country, and fielding new Rotary programs around the world.

Joe came into Rotary because he was a Group Study Exchange member to India in 1977. Two years later he joined

the St. Paul Rotary Club and has been active in many roles including president and charter member of District 5960 Board of Directors. He was chosen as the GSE team leader to the Philippines in 1999.

In 2002, Joe joined with PDG Steve Wilcox in developing the Visioning program for District 5960 clubs. Since then he has taught the how-to-visioning skills to facilitators in the United States, Canada, New Zealand, Australia and the western Caribbean. Currently Joe serves as Vice President of the International Vision Facilitation Council. At the 2012, Rotary International Convention in Bangkok, Thailand, Joe was a featured presenter on the topic of "Strategic Planning Made Easy." In 2014 he was the Zone training Coordinator for the Zones 28-29 Institute.

We will always remember Joe as the Governor who wanted all of us to become **"Fully Vested"** in Rotary. His initiatives were the 3-M's- Money, Mindfulness and Membership.




