



The Rotary Clubs of the Illawarra are organising a walk to raise awareness of the impact of Domestic and Family Violence on our community. This is part of a Rotary Multi National Campaign.

## **WHEN**

## Starting 10am on 29 November 2025

We will walk from the Fairy Meadow Surf Club to Stuart Park. The walk is approximately 2 kilometres and the walkway is very level. There is also ample room each side of the walking pathway on the grassy areas. A map of the of the walk is on the reverse side.

On completion of the walk there will be presentations on the impact of domestic violence by leaders in domestic violence and by local police.

Seating will be available and resources on domestic violence by local agencies.



## In Australia, Domestic and Family Violence is disturbingly common.

It is one of the drivers of homelessness among women, children, and men. Domestic and Family Violence crosses all boundaries, race, age, financial status, education, gender, and the suburb you may live in.

1 in 6 women and 1 in 16 men have experienced physical or sexual violence by a current or former partner. Alarmingly, on average 1 woman a week and 1 man a month is killed by a current or former partner (AIHW, Family Domestic and Sexual Violence Australia 2018).
