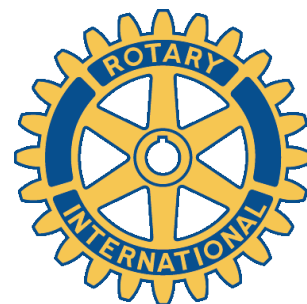


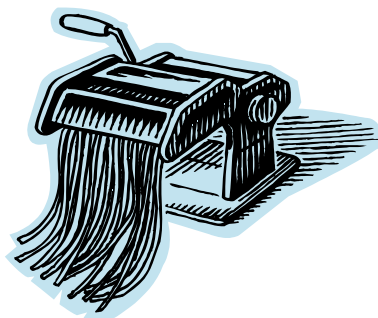

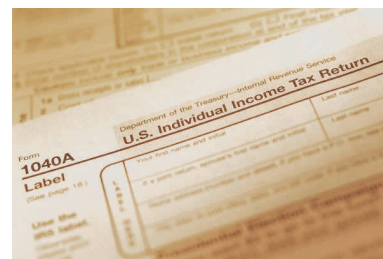
Spaghetti Dinner—May 9th—High School

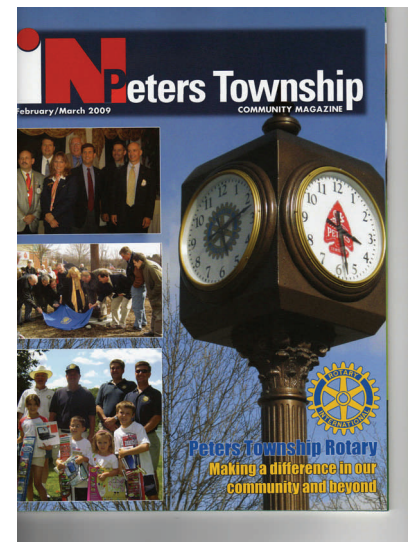

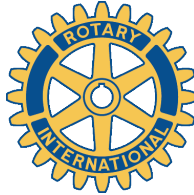
