CERTIFICATION of Membership

Eligibility for membership in the Rotary Club of Farmington requires the following:

1. Proposed member is business, professional or community leader with their primary business or residence located in the Farmington area.
2. Proposed member believes in the ideal of "Service Above Self" by fostering fellowship and friendship.
3. Proposed member is willing to provide their time and talents to further the club's success.

As the proposed member, I attest to the following:

1. I am eligible for membership in the Rotary Club of Farmington as stated above.
2. I have attended at least two meetings as a guest of the Rotary Club of Farmington.
3. I accept the attendance requirements. I understand make-up options that are available to me.
4. I agree to participate in the club's service projects and understand the service responsibilities.
5. I agree to participate in growing the membership of the club by inviting guests to club meetings.
6. I accept the financial obligation of membership including initiation fees, quarterly dues including meals costs and agree to make payments timely.

Financial Obligations include:

CERTIFICATION of Membership

Membership Process

1. Complete the application and submit it to your sponsoring member
2. Your sponsor endorses the application and forwards it to the Membership Chair
3. The Board of Directors reviews applications within two weeks
4. Upon acceptance, you'll be welcomed at the next club meeting by the president
5. A mentor will be assigned to help you get started
6. Choose a committee to join
7. Share a brief classification talk at a weekly meeting to introduce yourself
